Patients suffering from anorexia nervosa often have a distorted perception of their own body. They constitute one of the target groups for **BODYinTRANSIT**, a European Research Council-funded project seeking to use sensory feedback and virtual reality to engineer body-perception.

OMREN, the national research and education network of Oman, has successfully implemented (education roaming) wireless service across 32 institutions a sultanate. More than 500 researchers in Oman have used the service used by researchers in Oman during its first year of operation.

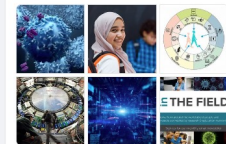

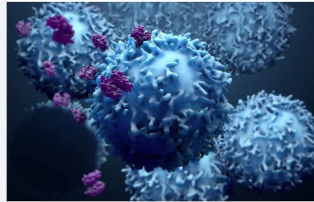

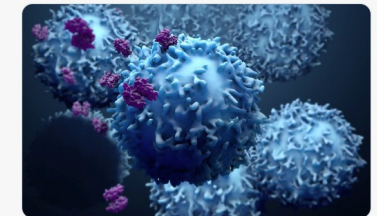
